

## CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-three of chapter one hundred and eight of the Acts of Assembly at the January session of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett county,'" and re-enact the same with amendments, extending the time for killing deer in said county, and giving permission to run wounded deer with dogs.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-three of chapter one hundred and eight of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the January session of one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett county,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Fine for violation.

SEC. 23. No person shall kill or destroy, or try to kill or destroy, any wild deer in said county, except during the months of October, November and December, and no person shall at any time catch or destroy any wild deer by running or chasing them by dog or dogs, unless the same shall have been first wounded, and for every violation of this section the offender shall, on conviction, pay a fine of not less than twenty-five nor more than fifty dollars.
