

CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Chesapeake Steam Navigation and Hotel Company to construct a bridge over Back creek, in the second district of Anne Arundel county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Chesapeake Steam Navigation and Hotel Company be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to construct and keep in repair a free bridge for the passage of carts, wagons, foot passengers, and the general convenience of travel over Back creek, in the second election district of Anne Arundel county.

Free bridge.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the said company, in building said bridge, shall have the same provided with a suitable and proper draw-bridge of a width of not less than twenty feet, so as to admit the full and free egress and ingress to and from said creek.

Width of draw.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
