SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter three hundred and ninety-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to repeal an act passed at the January session of the General Assembly, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and forty-one, entitled 'An act to repeal an act passed at the January session of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter ninety-nine,' entitled 'An act to lay off streets in Baltimore county, adjoining Baltimore city, and to repeal certain acts inconsistent therewith, and also to repeal the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter seventy eight,' entitled 'An act to supplement an act,' entitled 'An act to lay off streets in Baltimore county adjoining Baltimore city, and to repeal certain acts inconsistent therewith, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter ninety-nine, and also to repeal an act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter three hundred and eighty-seven,' entitled 'An act to repeal section four of an act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at its January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter ninety-nine,' entitled 'An act to lay off streets in Baltimore county, adjoining Baltimore city, and to repeal certain acts inconsistent therewith, and so forth,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional sections:

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted,* That whenever any examiner or examiners shall be appointed by the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, as provided for in sections four, five, eight, nine, ten and twelve of this act, he or they shall, after taking the oath required by the provisions of this act, before proceeding to collect any assessments made for benefits, by him or them, file a bond, with at least two
