CHAPTER 337.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Delaware Bay Railroad Company, so as to increase the number of directors to seven.

Increase directors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of Directors of the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Delaware Bay Railroad Company may, at any time when deemed necessary, increase the number of directors of said company, from the present number of five to seven, and said number, when so increased, shall be entered on the minutes of the company.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
