CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of twelve hundred dollars for each of the years of eighteen hundred and eighty and eighteen hundred and eighty-one, to "F. Knapp's English and German Institute," for the training and education of indigent mutes.

Authorized
to contract.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and is hereby authorized to contract with F. Knapp, of the city of Baltimore, for the tuition of twelve indigent deaf and dumb mutes, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty and eighteen hundred and eighty-one, at a cost not exceeding twelve hundred dollars per year, and for that purpose, on his requisition, the Comptroller is hereby directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for said sums, and the Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same.

CHAPTER 356.

AN ACT for the extension of the boundaries of the town of Easton, Talbot county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That article twenty of the Code
