

CHAPTER 360.

AN ACT to authorize the Inspector of Tobacco Warehouse number three to pay and settle the claims of Clarence C. Whiting and Henry R. Hazelhurst, for storage on tobacco deposited with them.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Inspector of Tobacco Warehouse number three be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to pay to Clarence C. Whiting, or his assigns, the sum of one thousand and sixty dollars and forty-four cents, for storage and cooperage on tobacco stored with him by order of the said Inspector of Tobacco Warehouse number three; and to pay to Henry R. Hazelhurst, or his assigns, the sum of one hundred and forty one dollars and fifty cents, for storage on tobacco deposited by him, by authority of the said inspector of number three warehouse; said sums of money to be paid out of the proceeds of any tobacco in said Tobacco Warehouse number three.

Who to pay to.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
