

which had been hitherto provided for by the State, was directed to and provided for at Western Maryland College, located at Westminster, Carroll county, Maryland; and whereas it appears that students have been appointed to and received by the said Western Maryland College, and that said college has most efficiently and faithfully complied with the requirements of said act, and that the appropriation for tuition as therein provided for will expire on the first day of June, eighteen hundred and eighty; therefore—

To pay annually.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the order of the Board of Trustees of Western Maryland College, the sum of twenty-six hundred dollars annually, in four equal instalments, on the first day of October, the first day of January, the first day of April, and the first day of July in each year; the first of said payments to be made on and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and eighty, for and during the period of two years.

When effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and eighty.
