CHAPTER 370.

AN ACT to permit the citizens of Queen Anne's county to shoot wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of Queen Anne's county.

How lawful.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That on and after the passage of this act it shall be lawful for the bona fide citizens of Queen Anne's county to shoot wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of said county, under such restrictions as hereinafter provided.

When prohibited

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the use of sink boxes as provided in this act is strictly forbidden in any creek, cove or inlet whose mouth is less than four hundred yards wide.

Must obtain license.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That no owner, master, hirer, borrower, employer of any owner, or other persons, shall use or employ any sink box of any description whatever for the purpose of shooting at wild water fowl therefrom in the waters described in this act, without first obtaining a license to so use and employ the same as provided in this act.

Who to grant

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's county shall, upon the application of any bona fide resident of Queen Anne's county, being the owner of any sink box, such as is allowed by this act, and desiring to obtain
