

CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Lonaconing, in Allegany county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the citizens of the town of Lonaconing, in Allegany county, are a body corporate by the name of the Mayor and Councilmen of Lonaconing, and by that name to sue and be sued, and have and use a common seal.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the limits of said town be as follows: Beginning at a post planted at the south-west corner of the bridge over Jackson run, on the county road leading from Lonaconing to Charlestown, and running south, seventy-six degrees west, four hundred and twenty-three feet; thence north, eighteen degrees west, one thousand and fifty feet; thence north, sixty degrees west, one hundred and eighty-two feet; thence north, eighty-two degrees west, five hundred and fifty feet; thence north, eighty degrees west, one thousand four hundred and fifty feet; thence north, forty degrees west, one thousand two hundred feet; thence north, fifty-five degrees east, one thousand feet; thence north, forty-five degrees east, eight hundred feet; thence north six hundred and thirty-one feet; thence north, twenty degrees west, five hundred and fifty feet; thence north, forty-eight degrees east, seven hundred and sixty-nine feet; thence south, thirty-five degrees east, one thousand and fifty feet; thence north, fifty-four degrees east, one thousand two hundred and forty-two feet; thence north, thirty-five degrees east, one thousand four hundred and fifty feet; thence south, fifty-eight degrees east, four hundred feet; thence south, three and one-half degrees west, two thousand five hundred and fifty feet; thence south, thirty-two degrees west, eight hundred and thirteen feet; thence south, twelve degrees west, seven hundred feet; thence south, six degrees east, four hundred and fifty feet; thence south, twelve and one-half degrees east, one thousand feet; thence south, five degrees east, four hundred and fifty feet; thence south, eighty degrees west, five hundred feet to the place of beginning.
