SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That no person shall shoot or in any manner catch, kill or have in possession, in Baltimore county, any partridges between the first day of January, said day included, and the first day of November next ensuing, in each and every year; nor any woodcock between the first day of February and the fifteenth day of June; nor any rabbit between the first day of January and the first day of November; nor any pheasants between the first day of January and the first day of September; nor shall any person trap any partridge or destroy or molest the eggs or nests of the said bird at any time in said county.

CHAPTER 393.

AN ACT to empower the Patterson and Druid Hill Parks City Passenger Railroad Company to accept subscriptions to its capital stock in personal property or real estate, or labor, or in either, or all personal property and real estate and labor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Patterson and Druid Hill Parks City Passenger Railroad Company, incorporated under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and forty-two, and approved April seventh, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, be empowered to accept subscriptions to its capital stock in personal property or real estate or labor, or in either, or all personal property and real estate and labor, at such valuations as may be agreed upon between the incorporation in said company and those
