

such evidence as they may deem sufficient of the approval and acceptance of said index by the Orphans' Court as aforesaid, and the entire completion of the same, levy such amount of money for the use of said Register as the Orphans' Court may deem sufficient to compensate him for said book containing such index, and for transcribing such index.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall go into effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 402.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and three of article six of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Caroline County," sub-title "Greensborough," as re-enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, and to enact the following in lieu thereof:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and three of article six of the Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "Greensborough," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following be and the same is hereby re-enacted in lieu thereof:

Give notice of election.

SEC. 103. If at any time an election shall not be held for commissioners at the time named in this article, an election may be held at any time after ten days' notice thereof shall have been given by the commissioners or a majority of them; and if the said commissioners shall fail or neglect to give such notice within the period of sixty days after the time named in this article for holding such election, an election may be held at any time after ten days' notice there-
