

Who to register. said sixth election district hereby made a part of said seventh election district, who may apply and be found legally entitled to be registered as voters in the first precinct of said seventh election district.

Inconsistent acts repealed. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent therewith are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 406.

AN ACT granting the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of five hundred dollars, in the last will and testament of Susan W. Snively, late of Washington county, deceased, to the trustees of the congregation worshipping in the Bethany Meeting House, at Downsville, and their successors.

Preamble. WHEREAS Susan W. Snively, late of Washington county, deceased, by her last will and testament, bearing date the nineteenth day of September, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, and duly admitted to probate and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Washington county, did direct the executor named in said last will and testament to pay five hundred dollars to the trustees of the congregation worshipping in Bethany Meeting House, in Downsville, Washington county.

Sanction given. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above-mentioned bequest of the said Susan W. Snively, deceased.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
