

CHAPTER 407.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-eight of the acts of assembly passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled Garrett county," and to re-enact the same with amendments providing for the payment of mileage to return judges of election.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-eight of chapter one hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled Garrett county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and
re-enacted.

SEC. 28. The judges of election in said county shall each receive two dollars per day for each day they shall be engaged as such judges in receiving and counting ballots; and return judges of election living more than three miles from Oakland in addition thereto, shall each receive as mileage eight cents per mile for each mile over three miles traveled by them in going from their place of residence to Oakland to make returns of any election; and return judges of election shall each receive two dollars per day for each day they may be occupied as such return judges in making said returns.
