

the same shall be collectable by said corporation as a common debt, according to law.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the members of said corporation, in case of loss by theft of any property described in section two of this act, and sustained by any member of said corporation, shall have power to arrest within the limits of the State of Maryland, any person or persons in whose possession such property may be found, or to arrest any person or persons when there exists a reasonable ground of suspicion that such person or persons stole the property or received it into his or their possession knowing it to be stolen; but in no case shall the said members be allowed to enter the premises of any person and search the same, unless accompanied by an officer with a warrant, as now authorized by the laws of the State of Maryland.

Power to arrest.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 411.

AN ACT to authorize the Comptroller to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay Wm. A. Twilly, late collector of State taxes for the seventh and thirteenth districts of Dorchester county, a sum of money overpaid by him into the State Treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay Wm. A. Twilly, late collector of State taxes for the seventh and thirteenth districts of Dorchester county, the sum of twenty-two dollars and thirty-five cents overpaid by him into the State Treasury, the same having received the endorsement of said officers.
