

CHAPTER 413.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the several bequests to charitable institutions contained in the will of Samuel E. Annan, late of Frederick county, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the following bequests to the charitable institutions contained in the will of Samuel E. Annan, late of Frederick county, deceased, dated the nineteenth day of December, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, and duly admitted to probate in the Orphans' Court of Frederick county, on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty, viz.: one thousand dollars to the Board of Foreign Missions of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America; one thousand dollars to the Board of Home Missions of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America, incorporated April the nineteenth, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, by act of the Legislature of the State of New York; five hundred dollars to the trustees of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America, for the use of the Presbyterian Committee of Missions for Freedmen; five hundred dollars to the trustees of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America, to be used in the spread of the Gospel among the Indians of the States and Territories of the United States of America; and the residue of his estate to the Tom's Creek Presbyterian Church at Emmittsburg, Frederick county, Maryland.
