

CHAPTER 423.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Howard county to rent a home for the purposes of an infirmary for the indigent sick of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Howard county be and they are hereby authorized, if they deem it desirable, to rent a home in said county for the purposes of an infirmary for the care of the indigent sick of said county.

Care of indigent sick.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

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CHAPTER 424.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and forty-four of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to repeal and re-enact as amended, section three of chapter two hundred and three of acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled 'An act to prevent stock running at large in Baltimore county, within five miles from Baltimore city,'" and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter two hundred and forty-four of the acts passed at the January session eigh-
