teen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to repeal and re-enact as amended section three of chapter two hundred and three of acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled 'An act to prevent stock running at large in Baltimore county, within five miles from Baltimore city,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Make sale of
stock.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That said justice of the peace shall be fully authorized to make sale of such stock if not returned as aforesaid; and out of all moneys arising from such sale made under the execution of this act he shall pay to the party taking up, if a constable or public officer, and impounding said stock, one dollar for his services therein, and also all other expenses incurred, and the remainder to the owner or owners who may establish claim to said property; and in the event of no such claimant appearing within thirty days thereafter, then the balance shall be paid into the school fund of Baltimore county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 425.

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in the waters of Frederick and Carroll counties.

When unlaw-
ful.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch or destroy any fish in the waters of Frederick or Carroll counties except with hook and line, or by use of the dip net; provided that the Potomac river shall be exempted from the provisions of this act.
