

Executive and Treasury Departments, the Land Office, the Secretary of the Senate and Chief Clerk of the House of Delegates, twelve hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the expense of fuel and lights for the public buildings and grounds, five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be expended under the direction and control of the Governor.

SCHOOLS.

To the several counties and the city of Baltimore, for the system of Free Public Schools, white and colored, and for the State Normal School and State Board of Education, to be apportioned by the Comptroller according to law, five hundred thousand dollars, or whatever sum may be paid into the treasury on account of the levy for public schools, and such other sum or sums as may be received to the credit of the Free School Fund from tax on the circulation of banks, and from interest on stocks standing to the credit of said fund, together with the sum of thirty-four thousand and sixty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be placed to the credit of the Free School Fund in accordance with the provisions of the act of the December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter thirty-three, and substituted for the interest on the surplus revenue as provided in said act; provided, that the sum of one hundred thousand dollars of the receipts from the public school tax shall be distributed for colored schools, after deducting the amount payable to the colored Normal School, and the balance to be distributed to the white schools, the State Normal School for whites and the State Board of Education, and the State Normal School shall not receive more than eight thousand dollars; that the Comptroller, in apportioning the five hundred thousand dollars appropriated by this section, shall not pay to the Principal of the State Normal School, either directly or indirectly, a sum above two thousand dollars; and that the State Board of Education is hereby prohibited from paying to the said Principal of the State Normal School any amount of the money hereby appro-
