of the Friendless of Baltimore city, three thousand dollars; for the salary of the Mine Inspector, twelve hundred dollars; to the newspapers in which shall be published the defaulters to the State previous to the election of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, to be distributed by the Comptroller upon bills rendered, one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; to the House of Reformation and Instruction for Colored Children, ten thousand dollars; to the Maryland Institute for the promotion of the Mechanic Arts, as provided by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter three hundred and thirteen, three thousand dollars; to the Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane, fifteen thousand dollars; to the State House of Correction, twenty-five thousand dollars, for the support of the institution.

Who to dis-
burse.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, or bodies politic or corporate, severally entitled to receive the same.

When effec-
tive.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and eighty-one.
