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CHAPTER 444.

AN ACT to repeal sub-section one hundred and thirteen of section three of chapter four hundred and eighty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to repeal article eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled 'Revenue and Taxes,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments, and re-enact the said sub-section so as to read as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sub-section one hundred and thirteen of section three of chapter four hundred and eighty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy four, entitled "An act to repeal article eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled 'Revenue and Taxes,' and to re-enact the same with amendments," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows, viz:

SEC. 113. All estates, real, personal and mixed; money, public and private securities for money of every kind passing from any person who may die, seized and possessed thereof, being in this State, or any part of such estate or estates; money or securities, or interest therein, transferred by deed, grant, bargain, gift or sale, made or intended to take effect in possession after the death of the grantor, bargainer,
