

three of the most public places in the neighborhood in which the offender may live, of the time and place of sale, and the said sale shall be for cash; and after deducting all costs and charges of advertising and making said sale, the balance of the proceeds of said sale shall be equally divided, and one half thereof shall be paid by the officer collecting the same to the informer, and the other half shall be paid by said officer to the treasurer of the school board, for the use and benefit of the public schools in said county.

Right of ap-
peal.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That any person or persons feeling aggrieved by the decision of the justice of the peace made and given under the provisions of this act, shall have the right to appeal to the circuit court for said county, and shall be notified of the said right of appeal, by the said justice of the peace, at the conclusion of the proceedings before him; provided, however, that no appeal shall be granted as aforesaid, unless the person so appealing shall first, within ten days after the entering of the judgment of the said justice of the peace, give a full and sufficient bond, with two good and responsible sureties, to be approved by the said justice of the peace to the State of Maryland, with condition to prosecute said appeal to the said circuit court at its next session thereafter, and also to pay the fine already imposed, together with all the costs, both before the justice of the peace and the circuit court, in the event the said judgment shall be affirmed.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That on information being given on oath to a justice of the peace of said county that a violation of any of the provisions of this act has been, or is being committed by any person or persons, the said justice of the peace shall forthwith issue his warrant, in the name of the State of Maryland, for the arrest of the offender or offenders, which warrant shall be directed to the sheriff or some constable or bailiff in said county, and the officer receiving said warrant may summon the posse comitatus, when necessary, to aid him in making any arrest under this act.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to prevent any of the
