

cise for the time being, the same powers and authority as the several constables in this State now have as conservators of the peace.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to stop his, her or their teams, horses, cattle, or any other animal, carriage, cart, wagon or any other vehicle, in any public or private road, or any other place within the distance of one half mile beyond and surrounding the grounds belonging to or controlled by the said association, during any fair or exhibition carried on and conducted under the auspices of the said association, any longer time than is absolutely necessary in the transaction of the legitimate business of him, her or them, then and there so stopping; and it shall also be unlawful for any person or persons to violate any of the provisions of this act or any of the by-laws, rules and regulations of the said association, not inconsistent with the laws of this State.

When unlawful.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*. That any person or persons who shall knowingly and wilfully violate any of the provisions of this act, or any of the by-laws, rules and regulations of the association, not inconsistent with the laws of this State, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace of Wicomico county, after a fair and impartial trial according to law, each and every person so convicted shall be fined by the said justice of the peace a sum of money not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars for the first offence, and not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars for each and every offence committed thereafter; and upon the default or failure of any person or persons to pay any fine or fines imposed in accordance with the provisions of this act, together with all the costs attending their arrest and conviction, the said justice of the peace before whom the same may be tried, shall immediately commit the said person or persons so failing to pay, to be confined in the jail of said county until the said fines and costs are paid.

Fine for violation.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That all fines imposed and collected under and in accordance with the pro-
