

in such extraordinary cases as may require shorter notice, and if any person being summoned shall neglect or refuse to attend with proper implements to do the work, or provide a substitute, or to pay on demand by the supervisor, his agent or deputy, the sum of seventy-five cents per day for each and every day he is summoned to work, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor; and the supervisor shall keep a list of all delinquents and report the same to a justice of the peace of the election district in which he is supervisor.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. **Effective.**
