Failure to elect.

SEC. 18. And be it enacted, That all the elections, which by this act, or by the by-laws of said company, are authorized to be made or held on a particular day, or at a particular time, if not made on such day or at such time, may be made or held at such other time and place as the said board of directors may appoint; provided thirty days' public notice thereof be given.

General meeting.

SEC. 19. And be it further enacted, That a general meeting of the stockholders of said company may be called at any time during the interval between the said annual meetings by the board of directors of said company, or a majority of them, or by stockholders owning at least one-fourth of the whole stock subscribed, upon giving thirty days' public notice of the time and place of holding the same; and when any such meetings are called by the stockholders, such notice shall specify the particular object of the call, and if at any such called meetings a majority (in value) of the stockholders of said company are not present in person or by proxy, such meeting shall be adjourned from day to day without transacting any business, for any time not exceeding three days; and if within said three days, stockholders having a majority (in value) of stock subscribed do not attend in person or by proxy, such meeting shall be dissolved.

Erect gate or gates.

Sec. 20. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said railway company, before the running of any trains on said company's road, to erect a gate or gates across Charles street avenue, and also across the road of the Baltimore and Harford Turnpike Company in Baltimore county, at the point where the track of said company's road shall cross the said avenue, and also at the point where the road of said railway company shall cross the road of said Harford Turnpike Company, in passing from the lands of James Brogden and wife to the lands of Robert Roach, in Baltimore county, in such manner that the same shall close said avenue and said road when trains are passing, and also maintain and keep up said gate or gates at all times, and also at all times keep employed at said crossings, a flagman, to give notice to persons using said avenue and road, of all
