

CHAPTER 465.

AN ACT granting the assent of the General Assembly of Maryland to a legacy granted to the vestry of Emanuel's (commonly called Baust's) church, in Carroll county, in the State of Maryland, by Elizabeth Catherine Erb, late of said county, deceased.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Elizabeth Catherine Erb, late of Carroll county, deceased, by her last will and testament, bearing date the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and duly admitted to probate and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Carroll county, devised and bequeathed to the vestry of Emanuel's (commonly called Baust's) church, in Carroll county, in the State of Maryland, the sum of one hundred dollars; therefore,

Sanction given.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above mentioned devise and bequest of said Elizabeth Catherine Erb, deceased.

CHAPTER 467.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Thomas Wilson Sanitarium for Children, of Baltimore city.

Duration limited.
