CHAPTER 479.

AN ACT to declare the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Elizabeth Wilson, late of Wicomico county, to the Old School Baptist Church in said county.

WHEREAS Elizabeth Wilson, late of Wicomico county, deceased, by her last will and testament, duly admitted to probate in the Orphans' Court of Wicomico county, on the twenty-first day of August, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, bequeathed to the Old School Baptist Church, in the town of Salisbury, and county aforesaid, a certain house and lot of ground situated on north-west corner of Division and west Chestnut streets, in the said town and county, where the said Elizabeth Wilson lived and died, to have and to hold the same, as the property of the said church, at the death of a certain Joseph C. Bell; therefore, **Preamble.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the said bequest. **Sanction and consent given**

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. **Effective.**
