

CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the devise of Mary J. S. Audoin, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, to Saint Joseph's Apostolic Society of the Sacred Heart for Foreign Missions of Baltimore city.

WHEREAS Mary J. S. Audoin, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, by her last will and testament, duly admitted to probate in the Orphans' Court for Baltimore city, on or about the seventeenth day of December, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, devised to Saint Joseph's Apostolic Society of the Sacred Heart for Foreign Missions of Baltimore city certain real estate situate in the city of Baltimore, which is fully set forth in said last will and testament; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the said devise.

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to give and declare the assent, sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the legacy or bequest of one thousand dollars, willed and bequeathed by John A. Gambrel, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, to the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Messiah in Baltimore city.
