SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the aforesaid bequest contained in the last will and testament of John Loats, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick.

Sanction given.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Frederick county," providing for the better protection of county bridges in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following section be and the same is hereby added to article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Frederick county," to be section 267 A of said article under sub-title "Roads."

Additional section

SEC. 267 A. It shall not be lawful for any person to affix any flood-gate, water-rack, fence or obstruction of any kind, to the free flow of water to any county bridge in Frederick county, or to place any flood-gate, water-rack, fence or obstruction of any kind to the free flow of water against any such bridge, and the road supervisors of said county are hereby authorized and required to remove any flood-gate, water-rack, fence or obstruction of any kind to the free flow of water, that is, or may be affixed

Unlawful to affix flood-gate.
