#### CHAPTER 4.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifty-eight of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Crimes and Punishments," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and fifty-eight of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Crimes and Punishments," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Frame regulations.

158. All persons confined in the jail of Baltimore city for offences punished by confinement in said jail shall, after conviction, be kept occupied at hard labor in some useful employment, and the Visitors of the said jail shall frame such regulations as may be necessary to the industry, quiet and discipline of the persons confined therein, who may have been
