CHAPTER 48.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Baltimore Corn and Flour Exchange, by authorizing the same, in its discretion, to become the owner of capital stock, and to participate in the organization and government of the Chamber of Commerce Building Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter one hundred and thirty-six, incorporating "The Baltimore Corn and Flour Exchange," be and the same is hereby amended so as that the said corporation be and it is hereby authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to subscribe for and otherwise acquire so much as it may see fit of the capital stock of "The Chamber of Commerce Building Company," and to participate in the organization and government of the same, provided always that the powers hereby granted shall be exercised subject to the limitations imposed by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland of the present session creating the said last-mentioned corporation.
