Effective.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT to repeal section one, chapter two hundred and eighty, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, "Providing for the protection of fish in Somerset county, Maryland," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one, chapter two hundred and eighty of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, "Providing for the protection of fish in Somerset county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Unlawful.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, except citizens of Somerset county, to use any patent twine, weirs, pound nets or hedges for the taking of fish in the waters of Somerset county.
