

Send extracts  
of deeds.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county be and he is hereby directed to make out and to send to the commissioner of the land office extracts of the deeds now recorded in the office of the said clerk which have been omitted by the former clerks, in the manner now provided for by law, and that for such work he shall receive such compensation as the law now provides for similar work.

Cost—how  
paid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the cost and expense of the work so directed to be done shall be paid by Anne Arundel county, and the County Commissioners for said county are hereby authorized and required to levy such sum as may be necessary to pay for the same, upon the certificate of the said clerk of the Circuit Court, showing the amount and that said work has been satisfactorily performed.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *And be enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
