CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to authorize the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railway Company to consolidate with the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railroad Company, or with it and certain other corporations hereafter to be chartered by the State of Pennsylvania, and to lease the railroad now owned by the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railway Company, and the line which may be hereafter owned by said consolidated company or companies, and to contract for the sale of the same, and for the making of arrangements for pro-rating between the companies.

Preamble.

WHEREAS a line of railway is now in course of construction by the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railway Company, from a point on the line of the Western Maryland Railroad to the Pennsylvania State line in Washington county, Maryland, from which last named point another line is in course of construction to the vicinity of Waynesboro, in the State of Pennsylvania, by the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railroad Company, a corporation chartered by the State of Pennsylvania, and it is likely that one or more other companies will be chartered by said State of Pennsylvania, for the purpose of constructing a continuous line of railway from the last-named terminus of said last-mentioned railway to or in the direction of Shippensburg, Pennsylvania.
