

Repeal. That sections two hundred and sixteen, two hundred and seventeen and two hundred and eighteen, of article twelve, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Garrett County," sub-title "State's Attorney," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Garrett. SEC. —. The provisions of section twenty-one, of Article ten, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Attorneys," sub-title "State's Attorney," shall apply to Garrett county as fully as if the same were herein re-enacted for said county in the language of said section.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with an amendment section twenty, of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Mayor and City Council."

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty, of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Mayor and City Council," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with an amendment so as to read as follows:

Electior. SEC. 20. The election for the members of the second branch shall be held on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every second year, accounting from the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT to amend an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, chapter four hundred and ninety-five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the National Trust and Guarantee Company," so that the corporate title of the said corporation shall hereafter be "The Baltimore Trust and Guarantee Company."
