

Lien. paving or otherwise improving the streets, lanes or alleys in said town, or any of them, or for any other purpose authorized by law, the sum levied shall be a lien on the lot or lots on which the same may be levied, or which may be owned by the person to whom they are chargeable until paid, and if such sum shall remain unpaid for sixty days after the same is due, and there shall be no personal property within the town on which the bailiff may levy, the same may be levied on so much of the real estate of the person owing such taxes as shall, in the opinion of the mayor and councilmen, be sufficient to pay the same, and the mayor and councilmen shall lay off the part so levied upon, and the bailiff shall after twenty days' notice in one or more newspapers printed in Allegany county of the manner, time and place of said sales, sell the part so laid off at public sale, and after deducting the expenses of said sale and paying the sums levied as aforesaid, shall pay over the balance, if any, to the owner of said property.

How to collect

Return, SEC. 25. *And be it enacted*, That the said bailiff shall make return of the said levy and all his proceedings therein, and about said sale provided for in the preceding section therein setting forth the times and length of notice and manner, times and places of publication or giving notice of said sale to the mayor and councilmen who shall forthwith deliver all of said returns together with all the proceedings under which the same was made to the clerk of the circuit court for Allegany county.

Proceedings, SEC. 26. *And be it enacted*, That upon return of said levy and proceedings to the circuit court, the same proceedings shall be had therein as provided by the Code of Public General Laws for constable's fees.

Ratification, SEC. 27. *And be it enacted*, That upon final ratification and confirmation of said sale by the circuit court for Allegany county, the mayor and councilmen, or the mayor and a majority of the councilmen shall execute and deliver to the purchaser a deed of the property sold with the seal of the town affixed, and the said deed shall convey to the purchaser the property sold.

Collect. SEC. 28. *And be it enacted*, That the bailiff of said town may make all collections required of him at any time within the year for which he was appointed bailiff.

Supervisors, SEC. 29. *And be it enacted*, That the mayor and councilmen may appoint a supervisor, or supervisors of the streets, lanes and alleys of said town, and direct in what manner the same shall be kept up and repaired, and may allow such supervisor such compensation for his services as they may deem reasonable.

Duties. SEC. 30. *And be it enacted*, That the bailiff of said town shall attend the meetings of the mayor and councilmen when required and perform such services as they shall direct; shall prevent the tumultuous and irregular meetings of dissolute and disorderly
