

commissioners of all sums collected and received by him, in which report he shall also include all receipts and disbursements on account of the "surplus fund" aforesaid, and a detailed statement of any and all collection by levy and sale of personal property, the name of the owner of property seized and sold, the price realized, his fees and expenses in such case, the amount of tax, of interest and penalties and of balance if any to credit of "surplus fund account."

Monthly statements **Sec. 117.** For making levy on personal property and thus enforcing payment of any tax, he shall be entitled to receive out of the proceeds of such sale a poundage fee of two per cent. on the amount of the sale and a levy fee of one dollar, or if the tax, interest, penalties and expenses be paid after actual levy, but before sale, then a poundage fee of one per cent. on the amount so paid and a levy fee of one-half dollar.

Fees. 180. The county commissioners shall annually at their laying session in March, estimate the sum of money probably necessary to pay jurors attending the circuit court for said county during the next fiscal year, and shall levy the same as an appropriation for such purpose.

To pay jurors. 181. A certificate signed by the clerk of the circuit court and stating the days the juror to whom such certificate is issued has attended and the sum due him therefor, shall be sufficient authority to the county treasurer to pay the amount therein specified out of any moneys remaining in his hands appropriated for such purpose by warrant of the county commissioners.

Certificates. **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 138.

AN ACT to incorporate the Woodberry and Belt electric light and power company.

Body corporate. **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That James E. Hooper, Francis E. Waters, W. Irving Walker, George Poole, Henry Hutton, all residents of the city of Baltimore, and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created and made a body corporate under and by the name and style of the Woodberry and Belt electric light and power company, and by that name shall have succession for the period of forty years, and shall be capable to sue and be sued, complain and defend in any court of law or equity, to make and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure, to receive and
