

CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Charles W. Clayville, late collector of State taxes for Worcester county, the amount over-paid by him into the treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay Charles W. Clayville, late collector of State taxes for Worcester county, the sum of twenty-three dollars and fifty-one cents, being the amount over-paid by the said Charles W. Clayville into the treasury as collector of State taxes for Worcester county for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, as certified by the comptroller and treasurer, the refunding thereof having received the recommendation of said officers.

To pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to regulate the sessions of the orphans' court of Charles county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the orphans' court of Charles county shall hold but two sessions in a month in each and every year, beginning on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and shall sit but one day at a session unless actual and pressing business requires it to sit for a longer time.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to repeal section two hundred and thirty-one, of article twelve, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Garrett county," sub-title "Witness."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and thirty-one, of article twelve, of the
