

was incorporated for the period of twenty-five years by an act of the General Assembly passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, that they are desirous their charter shall be extended for another term of twenty-five years; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the charter and corporate existence of the Baltimore warehouse company be and the same is hereby renewed and extended, **To extend.** and the same is hereby continued in existence as a body politic and corporate, from the time when according to the existing law the same will expire, for the period of twenty-five years, or until the end of the session of the General Assembly of Maryland to be held next after the thirty-first day of December, A. D., one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the said body politic and corporate for the period last aforesaid, shall have and hold all the rights, powers and privileges heretofore granted to it, with all the properties and other things now owned or held by it, and shall be subject to all the duties, restrictions, limitations and conditions imposed by the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter two hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore warehouse company, and the amending act passed at January session eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter one hundred and twenty-five, and the amending act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter fifty-four, and to all other acts of the General Assembly of Maryland amending or supplementing the acts aforementioned, or any of them. **Powers &c**

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. **Effective.**

CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT to give and grant the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry bequests of Arunah S. Abell, late of Baltimore county, deceased, for the use of the several religious and charitable organizations therein named.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly be and is hereby granted and given to the following bequests of Arunah S. Abell, late of Baltimore county, deceased; first, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Aged Men's Home," in the city of Baltimore; second, the bequest of one thousand dollars to the "Aged Woman's Home" in the city of Baltimore; third, the be- **To sanc- tion.**
