same time to the clerk of said county commissioners a written statement over their hand and signatures, setting forth in detail from whom, at what time and on what account the several items thereof were received by them respectively.

- Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effect ve. the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors in Pittsburg (No. 4) district of Wicomico county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and Unlawful ninety, it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court for Wicomico county to issue a license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Pittsburg (No. 4) election district of said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effective. the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to enlarge and extend the powers and franchises of the workingmen's permanent building and loan association of Talbot county, so as to enable it to make loans on promissory notes and to purchase evidences of debt.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the powers and franchises of the workingmen's permanent building and loan association of Talbot county, a body corporate Enlarged, duly incorporated under the general incorporation laws of the State of Maryland, be and the same are hereby enlarged and extended so as to authorize and permit said corporate body to make loans of unemployed funds or moneys to its members or other persons on promissory notes with a clause embodied in the same for the payment of attorney's commissions of collection in case of default of payment, to be accompanied with personal security or endorsement or with collateral security if desired, or both, and with any unemployed funds or moneys, to purchase bonds, notes,
