

thirty-first day of December of the year next succeeding the levy to complete the collection thereof, and to make his final settlement with the said county commissioners and with the treasurer of Maryland respectively; and he shall have until said time to complete his collections and make his final settlement whether his term of office has expired or not; and all claims for erroneous, insolvent or uncollectible tax-bills for which he shall claim a credit shall be presented before or at the time specified for said final settlement, and in no case shall the said commissioners allow credit therefor after the term specified for final settlement, and at the expiration of the time for final settlement his bond or bonds shall be liable for the unaccounted balance in his hands, and it shall be the duty of the county commissioners and they are hereby required to enter suit upon the county bond of said treasurer for all county taxes remaining uncollected.

Settlement

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of said treasurer to inform himself by all lawful means of all property, stocks or investments in said county liable to taxation, and not included in the lists furnished him and against which he has not tax-bill, and he shall value the same at the full cash value thereof, and collect the taxes therefor as upon other property in the county, and make return thereof to the county commissioners.

Assess.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That when land or personal property is in the hands of a trustee for sale or otherwise, whether by virtue of a decree of court or under a deed of trust, and the taxes thereon are in arrears the treasurer may enforce the payment of such taxes in the same manner as if said property were not in the hands of a trustee.

May enforce.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That all orders for the payment of money by the county commissioners, the road commissioners and the school commissioners respectively of Calvert county, when such orders become necessary shall be directed to the treasurer of Calvert county and shall be honored and paid by him so far as the funds in his hands for the purpose therefor drawn will permit.

Orders.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That at the general election of delegates every fourth year, counting from the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, there shall be elected a county treasurer for Calvert county by the legal qualified voters of said county, who shall hold his office for four years and until his successor is elected and qualified as hereinbefore provided, and be subject at all times to removal by the governor for wilful neglect of duty or misdemeanor in office, upon conviction in a court of law; and he shall not be eligible to re-election until after the interval of one full term; and the said treasurer so elected shall in all respects be clothed with the powers herein given and be governed by all the provisions of this act.
