Sec. 245. The county commissioners shall annually pay to the mayor and city council of Laurel when and as collected (but less the expenses of collection) all taxes levied or taxed for public roads on property within the limits of said town, which shall be expended by the said mayor and city council in the repair and improvements of the streets and roads within the limits of said

Road tax.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the following additional section be and the same is hereby added to said article seventeen, to be known as "Section two hundred and forty-six A."

246 A. CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay for land that may be acquired for the extension of the Maryland penitentiary and for the erection of necessary buildings thereon.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000,) To appro be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the priate. treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay for the land that may be acquired for the extension of the Maryland penitentiary and for the erection of necessary buildings thereon.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That the comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant on the treasurer, payable to the order of the board of directors of the Maryland penitentiary, for the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000,) annually for the years eighteen hundred and ninety,
