Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the charters of international telegraph district and construction company of Baltimore city, and of the Waterhouse electric company of Baltimore city, the Wenstrom dynamo and motor company consolidated, and the southern electric company of Baltimore city, and the Brush electric company of Baltimore city, heretofore formed in the city of Baltimore under the provisions of the general corporation law of this State, be and the Corpora- same are hereby amended so that said corporation may, and they are hereby authorized to transact any business in which electricity over or through wires may be applied to any useful purpose, and to that end all the rights and privileges mentioned in section one hundred and eleven, of article twenty-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," are hereby conferred upon said corporations in Baltimore city as fully and to all intents and purposes as though said corporations had been formed to carry on business in any city or town of Kent or Talbot county, and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
