CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the county commissioners of Montgomery county, to refund to William Veirs Bouic of said county, certain sums of money for taxes erroneously paid to said county commissioners by him.

- To refund.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Montgomery county, be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to refund and pay over to William Veirs Bouic of said county, the sum of two hundred and seventy-eight dollars and ninety cents, being money which the said William Veirs Bouic paid to the said county commissioners of Montgomery county, for county taxes on property erroneously assessed to him by said commissioners from the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three to the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, both inclusive.

- Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to authorize the county commissioners of Queen Anne's county to grant a pension to Edward H. Cray, of said county.

- Pension.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Queen Anne's county are hereby authorized and empowered to grant an annual pension, not exceeding fifty dollars, to Edward H. Cray of said county, during the natural life of said Cray, and to levy said amount on the assessable property of said county.

- Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
