CHAPTER 236.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and twenty-three, of article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Hyattstown," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repeal SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and twenty-three, of article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Hyattsville," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows :

Authority. 123. The county commissioners, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables and all State and county officers shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town as if this charter had not been granted, and the county commissioners of Montgomery county shall, on or before the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and on or before the first day of January in each and every year thereafter, pay over to the commissioners of said town that proportion of the entire county levy for the repair of roads which the total real property assessed within the limits of the town of Hyattsville bears to the whole amount of assessed property in Montgomery county, so that the **Roads.** commissioners of Hyattsville may receive and disburse for the repair and maintenance of the streets of said town the amount levied upon the real property within the corporate limits of the town of Hyattsville for the repair of roads by the said county commissioners of Montgomery county.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
