CHAPTER 237.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and three, of article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Gaithersburg," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and three, of article sixteen, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Gaithersburg," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Repeal

103. The county commissioners, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables and all other county and State officers shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town as if this Authority. charter had not been granted; and the county commissioners of Montgomery county shall, on or before the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and on or before the first day of January in each and every year thereafter, pay over to the commissioners of said town that proportion of the entire county levy for the repair of roads, which the total real property assessed within the limits of the town of Gaithersburg bears to the whole amount of assessed property in Montgomery county, so that the commissioners of Gaithersburg may receive and disburse for the repair and maintenance of the streets of said town the amount levied upon the real property within the corporate limits of the town of Gaithersburg for the repair of roads by the said county commissioners of Montgomery county.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the Effective date of its passage.

CHAPTER 238.

AN ACT to repeal section nine, of article thirteen, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," and to re-enact the same with an amendment.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section nine, of article thirteen, of the Code of Public Repeal General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
