CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Vansville district of Prince George's county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, No license That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court for Prince George's county to issue license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Vansville district of Prince George's county.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any Unlawful person to sell, barter or otherwise dispose of for gain any spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Vansville district of Prince George's county.

Effective. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 252.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article thirty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Estrays—vessels adrift, drift logs," sub-title "Estrays," to be numbered "eight A."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following be and the same hereby is added as an additional section to article thirty-four, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, to be numbered "eight A."

Sec. 8 A. The word enclosure in the preceding sections shall enclosure be construed to mean a common law enclosure and not an actual enclosure.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
