

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT to repeal section two hundred and ninety, of article seventeen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county," sub-title "Roads," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and ninety, of article seventeen, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's county," sub-title "Roads," be and hereby is repealed and the same is thereupon re-enacted so as to read as follows, viz:

Special tax. 290. In addition to the proper proportion of the general road tax levied annually for ordinary expenses of repairs of roads and bridges within the county, the county commissioners shall have power, in their discretion, upon the petition of thirty or more land-owners in any district, to levy upon the assessable property therein an additional and special tax of not more than ten cents on the hundred dollars, to be collected as other county taxes, and expended solely for the improvement of the roads and bridges within such district, under the direction of the county commissioners; provided, however, that if in any case a majority of the tax-payers of such district shall designate in writing three persons in such district to act as a board of special road commissioners for such district, who shall in like manner consent to act in the premises without compensation; thereupon the county commissioners shall by order ratify such designation and appointment, and such board so constituted shall be entitled to demand and receive such special tax as collected, and to expend the same for the purpose aforesaid.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section five, of Article three, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore county," sub-title "Birds and Game."

Repeal. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section five, of article three, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore county," sub-title "Birds and Game," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

SEC. 5. No person shall shoot, or in any manner catch, kill or have in possession, in Baltimore county, any rabbit between the twenty-sixth day of December, said day included, and the first
