### CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifty-six, of article three, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore county," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and fifty-six, of article three, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore county," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," be and the same is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

### CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to empower the county commissioners of St. Mary's county to levy a sum of money for the building of a school-house for colored children in Piney Point Section, second election district of St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of St. Mary's county, be and they are hereby empowered and directed to levy for the building of a school house for colored children in Piney Point section, second election district of St. Mary's county, such a sum of money as in the opinion of the said commissioners may be sufficient for the purpose herein before specified. To levy.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the school board of St. Mary's county build the school-house provided for in this act in such a vicinity of Piney Point and St. George's section as they may agree. To build.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
