

tice may commit the party fined to the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days, and the sheriff of Carroll county shall receive and confine the party so committed in the same manner as other prisoners, and shall be entitled to the same compensation therefor. May commit.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all laws inconsistent with, or repugnant to the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency, and this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Bel Air turnpike company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section eight, of chapter four hundred and ninety-two, of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, entitled "An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the northern terminus of the Baltimore and Harford turnpike road to the town of Bel Air, in Harford county," be and the same is hereby repealed, altered and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed.

SEC. 8. That said company shall be and they are hereby invested and clothed with all the rights, privileges, immunities and advantages which are held and possessed by the turnpike road company, incorporated by an act passed at November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the district of Columbia to the city of Baltimore, and be entitled to the same tolls, except so far as said last named act by the thirteenth section thereof, prohibits the Bel Air turnpike company from charging any person or persons living on or adjacent to the said road, within three miles from its toll-gate or turnpike, any toll for the passing of said gate more than once in twenty-four hours, and the said turnpike company is hereby authorized to charge any person or persons for passing through its gate, without reference to his or their living adjacent thereto or within three miles thereof, or of said turnpike road. Rights.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the following section be and the same is hereby added to the charter of the Bel Air turnpike company, that is to say: Additional section.

SEC. 10½. Every traction engine passing through the toll-gate of the Bel Air turnpike company shall pay for each horse power of said engine the same toll as if each horse power represented a horse attached thereto; and when the tires of the wheels of traction en- Toll.
