

tures to the said county commissioners of their actions and expenditures, giving the name of every person to whom money was paid in erecting said building and furnishing the same; and the said county commissioners shall cause the said report to be published once in the usual manner of publishing public matter in said Montgomery county.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That for the purpose of paying for said new court house and furnishing the same, the said county commissioners of Montgomery county are hereby authorized and directed to borrow on the credit of said county an amount not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, and to issue coupon bonds therefor in sums of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars each, to be signed by the president of the board of county commissioners and its clerk and sealed with the seal of the office; said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four per centum per annum payable semi-annually and dated on the day of their issue; said bonds shall be advertised and sold to the highest bidders at not less than their face value by the county commissioners of said county for cash.

Bonds.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That said bonds shall be issued to mature at twenty-five years from their date but shall be redeemable at the pleasure of said county commissioners at or before their maturity; that to redeem said bonds the county commissioners of said county shall annually levy upon the assessable property of said county a tax sufficient to pay the interest thereon and two thousand dollars of the principal debt, and said levy shall be designated as the "Court House Debt Fund."

To redeem

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the bonds hereby authorized shall be exempt from all taxation, and that interest on said bonds shall be received by the collectors of said county in payment of the county taxes.

Exempt from tax.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That during the time said new court house is being erected the county commissioners of said county shall provide suitable rooms in the town of Rockville for the public offices of said county and for the holding of the terms of the circuit court for said county.

Temporary rooms.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to protect trout in the streams of Frederick county.
